 - Matt Chandler Where your giftedness and passion collide PAY ATTENTION!.
 - Russell Moore In the New Testament, we don't find our gift through self-examination and introspection and then find ways to express it. Instead, we love one another, serve one another, help one another, and in so doing we see how God has equipped us to do so.
 - Billy Graham Some people have a warped idea of living the Christian life. Seeing talented, successful Christians, they attempt to imitate them. For them, the grass on the other side of the fence is always greener. But when they discover that their own gifts are different or their contributions are more modest (or even invisible), they collapse in discouragement and overlook genuine opportunities that are open to them. They have forgotten that they are here to serve Christ, not themselves.

NOTES:

- The same gift shared through different contexts and personality will probably look different.
- Every gift is **needed** and **special** there are no unimportant gifts.

One Gift - JESUS

 Brother Yun - Do not be satisfied with God's calling or His gifts in your life. Be satisfied with Jesus Christ Himself.

Watchman Nee - God will not give me humility, or patience, or holiness, or love as separate investments of His grace. He has given only one gift to meet our need, His Son Christ Jesus.

- No Complete List At least 5 partial lists. (Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 1 Corinthians 12:28, Ephesians 4:11, 1 Peter 4:11)
- He gives GIFTS (Ephesians 4:8)
- Paul was said to be an Apostle AND Teacher (1 Timothy 1:11)

Be Humble

- Just a CHANNEL
- Hymn Channels Only (https://library.timelesstruths.org/music/Channels_Only/)
- There is GREAT FREEDOM in realizing that we are ONLY a channel
- The greatest hindrance to God using us is that He HAS USED us in the past.

Be an Encouragement

- Mistakes are OK in a family.
- o Gifts are not as effective alone.
- o Given and received in LOVE.
- o Say THANK YOU!
